

Sexplained Challenge

The Sexplained Challenge is an innovative contraception and sexual health quiz for teams of 4 people. You can have as many teams as you like in your venue for a local/regional round. The winning team goes through to a national final of 24 teams.

What sort of questions?

There are 6 rounds of 8 questions. Subjects covered include: myths and legends, contraception, HIV/AIDS, herpes and hepatitis, other common STIs, male and female health issues with some general knowledge questions to make it feel less threatening for some! There are also 2 picture identification rounds (male/female reproductive systems and common STIs).

How long does it take?

The Sexplained Challenge takes about 2 hours, with an interval.

Who provides the questions?

The Sexplained Foundation will provide a set of question cards and one set of answer sheets. The answer sheets can be photocopied as required. A score sheet will also be supplied which should be returned to the Foundation, so that the winning team can be invited to the finals.

Who asks the questions?

The Sexplained Foundation can supply a question master, or you can supply your own, but it is recommended that the

person should have a good knowledge of the topics to answer questions arising from the quiz, thus making the event an awareness raising opportunity.

When should the quiz take place?

Local/regional rounds of The Sexplained Challenge can take place at a time to suit you before the end of March. In May/June 2005 we hope to run the UK finals.

What does it cost?

To help cover administrative costs and further the work of the Foundation we hope to raise £500 for each running of the quiz.

The Foundation is approaching sponsors, but it is suggested that a fee of £1 per person be made or teams could be asked to get themselves sponsored by family, friends etc.
